SOA towards CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (Release 4)



This VET Board Endorsed course aims to provide students with the foundation knowledge and the elementary skills required to provide support in a child care setting in a safe and efficient manner.

The qualification is recognised as an entry-level qualification for employment in the childcare industry and provides opportunities to:-

- Apply knowledge & understanding of WHS and operational requirements in the childcare industry.
- Set up play and learning experiences for young children.
- Promote healthy eating and the well being of children.
- Support learning and development of young children, both under supervision and autonomously.
- Communicate effectively with colleagues, parents and children.
- Work independently and in teams.

Qualification	Students undertaking the 240 hour course may achieve a Statement of Attainment in CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.
Assessment	<p>Holistic Assessment is used to assess students against a range of elements of competency. One assessment task may include a number of competencies. The methods used for collecting evidence of competency may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workplace journals and reports • Case Studies /simulation exercises • Portfolios and research assignments • Oral questioning and presentations • Finished products • Practical demonstration of specific skills/knowledge <p>The performance criteria used for assessment are contained in the units of competency. http://training.gov.au/Training/Details/CHC30113 Students will be awarded a Competent (C) or Not Competent (NC) based on the achievement of the performance criteria.</p>
